The Yorba Linda Veterans Memorial Association is seeking permission from the City to make another improvement to the Memorial. We wish to create a "flag stand wall" that will wrap around the existing wall where the bronze plaques are mounted recognizing past conflicts.

We have purchased flags to represent each of the six branches of the military as well as flags to recognize the American Legion, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the Gold Star Moms Association. We would want to display these nine flags during our ceremonies on Memorial Day and Veterans Day each year and we believe these flags would look best if displayed in a row adjacent to and running slightly behind the existing plaque wall. To accomplish this, we would need to build a small concrete wall that will hold flag pole mounts that will be used only during our two ceremonies each year. This new wall would be behind and mostly below the line of sight but be high enough to allow the flags to fly above the top of the plague wall during the ceremony.

The YLVMA intends to fund this project through existing funds on hand and donations for the project. With the City's permission, we would hope to complete this project in time for our Memorial Day ceremony on Monday, May 30, 2022.
