#### AMENDMENT NO. 5 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ("Amendment No. 5") is made and entered into this 1st day of March 2022, by and between the City of Yorba Linda, 4845 Casa Loma Avenue, Yorba Linda, California 92886, a municipal corporation of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "City"), and Michael Baker International, Inc., 14725 Alton Parkway, Irvine, California 92618 (hereinafter referred to as "Consultant").

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City and the Consultant entered into an On-Call Professional Services Agreement dated December 12, 2016 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City and the Consultant desire to enter into an amendment to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant desire to amend the scope of services specified in Section 3.1.1 of the agreement to include additional Design Engineering and Pre-construction services for the Bastanchury Road Widening (from Casa Loma Avenue to Eureka Avenue) Project; and

WHEREAS, the City and the consultant desire to amend the compensation specified in Section 2.1 Contract Sum of the Agreement will be amended to include an additional Twenty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars (\$25,523) for additional Design Engineering and Preconstruction services for the Bastanchury Road Widening (from Casa Loma Avenue to Eureka Avenue) Project per Amendment No. 5; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. In accordance with Section 3.1.1 General Scope of Services of the Agreement, the scope of services provided in <u>Attachment "A"</u> of Task Order No. 2 of the Agreement is amended to include the additional scope of services described in Consultant's Scope Amendment Proposal attached hereto as Attachment "A-2".
- 2. In accordance with Section 3.3.1 <u>Compensation</u> of the Agreement, and Exhibit "A" Schedule shall include an additional **Twenty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars (\$25,523)** for additional Design Engineering and Pre-construction services for the Bastanchury Road Widening (from Casa Loma Avenue to Eureka Avenue) Project, increasing the total not to exceed Agreement Task Order amount to **Three Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$364,789)**.

Except as amended pursuant to this Amendment No. 5, all provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect, and shall govern the services provided under this Amendment No. 5.

The revision required the following out of scope tasks:

- **17.0 Additional Field Survey:** Complete additional topographic survey inside private properties which is needed to re-design the retaining wall and associated grading
