SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 2023-5844 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS PERTAINING TO THE ANNUAL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 2023-5844 authorizing the City Manager to execute agreements and other documents necessary to facilitate the City's participation in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

On an annual basis, the City of Yorba Linda participates in the CDBG program. The purpose of the CDBG program is to assist communities in providing decent housing and suitable living environments and in expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income. For many years, the City has participated in a Cooperation Agreement with the County of Orange for joint participation in the City's CDBG program. Under this designation as a Metro City, Yorba Linda receives its full entitlement amount in accordance with the federal formula which allocates funding to eligible jurisdictions. As a Metro City, the County assists with specific documents, monitoring and reporting requirements and shares in the administrative costs related to the CDBG contracts. One of the steps in the participation process is to pass a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute all CDBG agreements, contracts, and other documents.
