Re: Recycle Center at Costco Yorba Linda

As a designated convenience zone, Costco located in Yorba Linda is committed to fulfilling the obligations of recycling within a convenience zone in a way that makes sense for the business, recycler and the public in a safe and efficient manner.

We feel we can safely manage a recycler safely within the boundaries of our large parking lot. We have identified a few locations where the traffic is light and there is sufficient parking for the public to safely access the recycler, such as the far east entrance, the corner of the building between the gas station and tire center and the parking lot side of the wall separating the receiving dock from the parking lot.

The far east entrance and the parking lot side of the wall separating the receiving dock from the parking lot are ideal locations as our managers and supervisors park near that area and make it easy for us to manage the traffic and cleanliness throughout the day. The location in between the gas station and tire center is a slow traffic corner and can be seen by our gas station supervisor and tire center manager. Additionally the gas station and tire center are frequently visited by management throughout the day who will be able to check on the recycler.

It has been pointed out that the back of the building might be a good place for the recycler, specifically next to or across from the wall that separates the receiving dock from the parking lot and on the receiving side of the wall.

We strongly disagree with this location due to the amount of traffic that passes through that entrance to our receiving area. The receiving area has multiple trucks of all sizes delivering throughout the day. This area is also used by vendors who service the building as a parking and staging area.

We are open to other areas of the parking lot that make sense for a safe location.
