**SUBJECT:** APPROVE RESOLUTION NO. 2026-5979 ESTABLISHING CITYWIDE POSTED SPEED LIMITS

### RECOMMENDATION

Approve Resolution No. 2026-5979 establishing citywide posted speed limits as shown in the attached Engineering and Traffic Survey.

### SUMMARY

State law requires the City to periodically review posted speed limits using an Engineering and Traffic Survey. Approving the resolution will establish the updated citywide posted speed limits based on the survey.

### DISCUSSION

The City retained AGA Engineers, Inc. to prepare a citywide Engineering and Traffic Survey in compliance with California Vehicle Code. The survey reviewed 120 roadway segments and included radar speed surveys, roadway field reviews, and collision history analysis.

The survey found that existing speed limits should remain in place on most City-maintained streets, but recommends speed limit reductions on two segments:

Street	Location	Existing Speed Limit	Recommended Speed Limit
Dominguez Ranch Rd	Trailside Dr to Esperanza Rd	35	30
Old Canal Rd	Mirage St to Savi Ranch Pkwy	35	30

The attached Engineering and Traffic Survey provides the basis for the recommended posted speed limits and supports their continued enforceability.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The cost to replace speed limit signs is approximately \$1,000 and is included in the Public Works operating budget.

**ALTERNATIVES**

Do not approve the recommended action and provide alternative direction.
